We're delighted that you are interested in the Mountain Magic Adult Girl Scout Weekend! Unfortunately, Council still has strict restrictions in place for overnight events that will continue through January 2022 that have made a weekend event impossible. So, we've decided to change to a day-only event and have a **Mountain Magic Leader CELEBRATION!!**

The planning committee has been working hard to work thorough all these changes, and we're looking forward to bringing you a spectacular event! We have a HUGE lineup of fun classes in store for you!

Our 20th anniversary event will be held on January 22, 2022 at Holy Cross Catholic Church in Atlanta, GA. Cost for the event will be \$25.

All participants will receive a personalized event folder and class schedule, nametag/swap necklace, custom patch, and an optional lunch. Please note: many classes have additional fees, which must be

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paid at time of registration. Participants may bring a sack lunch or optionally purchase a Chick-fil-A boxed lunch during registration. NOTE: Classes will fill in the order that participants register. Register early for best selection! Detailed confirmations and event specifics will be sent to you in early January.

We are offering a Day Only Pass this year to comply with GSGATL COVID guidelines. Registration will be open from 11/20 – 12/20 ONLY. Event Fee \$25.00

Training Only (You are a trainer only coming to teach your class on Saturday and not take any other classes). Registration fee \$0.

Who May Attend

Site

Since we'll be hosting a day-only event this year, we're staying closer to home. The Mountain Magic Leader Celebration will be held in the Educational Building at Holy Cross Catholic Church, located at 3157 Hathaway Ct, Atlanta GA 30341 (back entrance, recommended); the main entrance is 3773 Chamblee Tucker Rd, Atlanta GA 30341. The church is located on Chamblee-Tucker Rd., just outside the perimeter in northeast Atlanta.

Transportation/Parking

Carpooling is recommended. We recommend using the back entrance to the church (use 3157 Hathaway Ct., Atlanta, GA in your GPS). Circle behind the building for parking – there will be plenty of signage for you to follow. You may also park in the front parking lot and walk around to the back of the church property.

Event Agenda

During the event, there will be lots of time for learning as well as fun. Registration begins at 7:30 AM until 8:15 AM – classes start promptly at 8:30 AM. Lunch is from noon – 1PM and our event will end at 6:30 PM. Visit http://www.3leaves.org/mm2022/Agenda.html for the complete agenda.

Offered Classes, Workshops, and Activities

There are 29 different classes offered, including 15 NEW classes for this year! We are supporting the GSGATL focus on STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) initiatives, the Great Outdoors, and Older Girl Training, too! Look for these icons:







Detailed descriptions, class supply lists, length, class fee, and instructor name are posted, along with photos for many of the classes. Remember, to ensure the best selection of classes, register EARLY! Classes fill up in the order that registrations are received.

Our classes/workshops are designed to enhance your personal growth and program skills for leading girls. And, activities are just plain fun! Our high-quality sessions are presented by knowledgeable instructors and/or licensed professionals; some sessions may have an additional fee. You MAY NOT just drop in; you must be registered in order to attend a class. The number of participants for each class/workshop/activity is limited. All are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. **During online registration, you will select your first-choice class during each time slot.** If your first choice is full, you should select an alternate choice from the available classes AND request to be added to the waitlist for your first-choice class. (You will be contacted if a space becomes available in your waitlisted class). REGISTER EARLY so you won't be disappointed!

There will be limited opportunities to "switch" classes once registered. When you receive your final confirmation packet in December, please pay close attention to the classes you are scheduled to attend. Please contact our registrar, Marie Wright, immediately if there are any discrepancies so that we may make adjustments prior to your arrival at camp. All class changes must be made **NO LATER THAN DEC**31st so that we can provide our instructors with accurate class rosters and reimburse them appropriately. Instructors may NOT accept "walk-ins".

Meals & Snacks

Participants may bring a sack lunch from home or may optionally purchase a Chick-Fil-A boxed lunch for \$10 during registration. All participants will be provided complimentary bottled water during lunch; Coke and Diet Coke will be available for purchase during lunchtime for 50¢. Participants may wish to bring a few snacks to eat between classes.

SWAPS

Swaps are the tradition of Girl Scouts exchanging keepsakes. They were started long ago and were originally exchanged at National Girl Scout Senior Roundups (referred to as "Special Whatchamacallits Affectionately Pinned Somewhere"). Swaps are still the perfect way for Girl Scouts to meet each other, promote friendship and remember a special event or Girl Scout Sister. At our Leader Celebration, many participants exchange Swaps to remember the friends and fun they share all event, but this is optional (however, you may not get any from others if you don't have some to trade).

Swaps often represent the event theme (our event theme this year is the Roaring 20s). So, make some to bring with you or you can make some at the event to exchange with other participants. Participants should plan to bring around 30-50 SWAPS. We will be providing unique Swap necklaces to all participants. Need more info? What to Bring

A personalized class schedule will be sent to you in December; your final schedule email will be sent in January and will include the supply list for the specific classes you are attending. You may also wish to bring a water bottle (you can refill your bottles) and snacks to eat between classes. Don't forget your mask (masks are required while indoors, per the current GSGATL Covid Guidelines).

Freebie Table

Once again, we'll offer a "freebie" table. It's "bring some/take some"! Be sure to bring your unused craft supplies, badges/patches, camping gear, etc. to donate to other Girl Scouts. Stop by the "freebie" table and help yourself. Please do NOT bring your trash. Anything not taken by the end of the day will be discarded.

Discounts/Volunteer Perks

Discounts are given to our class instructors and to campers who work as a camp helper during one or more class timeslots. **Instructors** receive \$5 off the registration fee for each class they teach. **Camp Helpers** will receive a \$5 rebate to offset class fees at the conclusion of the class session. Camp helpers collect class rosters, take pictures, and assist the director. Note: this job involves walking around the building, so please consider this as this assignment may not be practical for those who are mobility impaired. Sign up to be a Camp Helper when you register (limited opportunities)!

Optional Items for Purchase & Silent Auction

You will pay for your registration, classes, and meal (optional) at the time you register. OPTIONALLY, you may wish to bring some additional cash for sodas/bottled water (after lunch) and for our decorations silent auction (end of day Saturday). These are OPTIONAL opportunities which we make available to you as a service. Silent Auction – Our decorations silent auction will take place throughout the day on Saturday (auction bid forms will be near registration). All proceeds from the silent Auction will go to towards our philanthropy project this year.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

In our twenty- year history, we have **never** had to cancel our event due to inclement weather or other unforeseen events. But with that said, *if we must cancel our event, no refunds will be given*. Most of our fees are spent well before the event (location rental, food contracts, patches, supplies, etc.) If the event cancels, you will be notified by email and our website will be updated at least 24 hours before the event. We would be as heartbroken as you in the unlikely chance of cancellation! If we haven't announced a cancellation at least 24 hours in advance, the event is ON!!

Did your plans change? Do you need to cancel? Refunds will be sent via check (less a \$10 processing fee) and will be given for written cancellations <u>only</u> that must be postmarked/email date stamped no later than **30 days prior to the event at 5:00 PM**. Substitutions will be allowed pending class availability (with a \$10 processing fee) up to 7 days before the event. Contact Marie at 404-915-2342 if you will be taking the place of someone else.
