What is Camporee?

Camporee is an opportunity to share Girl Scout sisterhood with all the troops in our Service Unit. Our Service Unit Camporees are held at Camp Twin Lakes in Rutledge, GA over the Veteran's Day weekend in November.

Each year we gather together for a weekend of camping and activities facilitated in part by the camp Twin Lakes team, and in part by the host troop.

Camporee is a great way for troops and girls to bond with other scouts of all ages in our Three Leaves Service Unit.

All meals, activities, and a fun patch are included in the cost for two-night camping.

Troops may also participate in Saturday-only "9-5" activities for a reduced cost, which includes lunch. Saturday campers will arrive in the morning, participate in morning activities, have lunch, participate in afternoon activities, and then depart before dinner.

Saturday-only Camporee is a wonderful introduction to camping for Daisy scouts.

Each registered troop will be assigned their own cabin that sleeps 12 in twin-sized camp beds. You may bring an air mattress to accommodate two additional campers. Each cabin has two toilets, two sinks, and two showers. If your group is larger than 14, you may fill an additional cabin if available, or extra adults can sleep in a separate counselor cabin.

Two non-related adult campers must accompany each troop. You must also have a first-aid/CPR certified adult camper from your troop present for the entire Camporee. All participating adults must be registered Girl Scouts.

Every year the host troop selects a theme, and the participating troops will express this theme in their outside cabin decorations, optional costumes, and usually in the Saturday night skit if they choose. There are contests for cabin decorating and skits.
